Development of a cohort over time

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#### **Key Indicators**

- Applications and Intake
- Active PhDs (+/- Public Presentation | Time-to-Public Presentation)
- Completion Rates and Time-to-Degree (TTD)
- Gender | Nationality (AT | DE | EU | DRITT)
- Funding-Status (FULL | PART | NONE)
- Funding-Sources (INTERNAL | THIRD PARTY)
- Study Clusters and Cohort Compositions (Success | Ongoing | Dropout)

#### Influencing Variables for Performance

- Development of Applications/Intake due to entry requirements
- Completion Rates Funded vs. Non-Funded PhDs
- TTD depending on Gender, Nationality, Study Cluster, ...







#### Reporting

#### **STATUS QUO**

- Standardized Doc:Monitor Report 1x per semester
- Ad Hoc Reports for Directors of Study Programmes, Rectorate, Finance, HR, ...

#### OUTLOOK

- Monitoring aligned to PDCA Cycle, close contact to stakeholders
- Standardized as well as tailor-made reports, directly accessible in DataWareHouse
- Stronger focus on student surveys, integration of qualitative data

- Supporting/organizing lectures or trainings on transferable skills;
- Consulting PhDs on career topics,
- Establishing relations with potential employers
- Dealing with legal issues in doctoral education;
- Supporting university boards, committees;
- Management of doctoral /graduate school;
- Quality control/assurance and data monitoring;
- Initiating and managing third party funded projects on doctoral education;
- Preparing and evaluating data in the field of doctoral education;
- Supporting curriculum development;
- Introducing good scientific practice....
